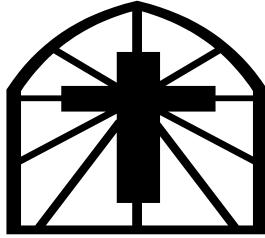

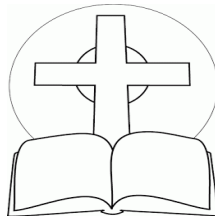

Admissions

We have now offered places to 20 parents who wish their children to start school in September 2017. Parents who have not been offered a place are welcome to go to appeal through the LEA.

It is likely that the school will not be making a formal objection to the appeals. Please contact school as soon as possible if you need any further information regarding this process and to access an Appeal Form.

Class Structure

In September, it is highly likely that we will have 5 classes.

Class L : mixed reception and year 1

Class H : mixed year 1 and year 2

Class K : mixed year 3 and year 4

Class C : mixed year 4 and year 5

Class G : mixed year 5 and year 6

When we need to split year groups, we always do this on ability using our comprehensive assessment data gathered throughout the year.

SATS 2017

The year 6 SATS were completed in mid-MAY.

We now await the results which are due out in early July.

The children sat tests in

- Reading,
- Punctuation,
- Grammar and Spelling
- Mathematics
- Writing was graded following external moderation.



We really hope that they've all done well and have achieved their potential and we hope to maintain our good levels of attainment compared to other schools both locally and nationally.

PGL Holidays

The year 4 and year 5 children went on separate adventures to the PGL camp at Winmarleigh Hall near Lancaster.

All the children had a fabulous time and many pushed themselves to go beyond their "comfort zone" and really challenge themselves on the climbing, canoeing, zip wire and giant swing activities etc.

Thanks to Mrs Carne, Mrs Galley, Mrs Kendall, Miss Hampson and Mrs Harrison for giving up their time to look after the children. They were real stars!

Solo, 14 day, 2,000 mile sail around Iceland – Mr Andrew Bedwell

One of our prospective dads Mr Andrew Bedwell, whose daughter starts at Halsall CE in September 2017 is a very experienced Yachtsman. He is hoping to raise money for the school (for playground and sports equipment) by sailing solo and non-stop, from the Lake District across the North Atlantic, around

Iceland (yes Iceland!) and back. The marathon trip of 2,000 miles will take about 2 weeks to complete depending upon the weather conditions. Fingers crossed then. Mr Bedwell hopes to set off early in June. He'll have to contend with a terrible lack of sleep and physical exhaustion, the danger of passing ships, whales and icebergs and his home for those 2 weeks will be the size of a large fridge. This is a tremendous gesture by Mr Bedwell and we hope that parents and children will get involved and follow his route and help donate towards our project. To encourage people to donate, Mr Bedwell has very kindly offered to provide a maximum of 10 sailing expeditions as an incentive.

£25 + donation : name goes into a hat for a 2 day sail

£100 buys a 1 day sail for 2 people (possibly towards the Isle of Man or just along the coast)

£200 buys a 2 day sail for 2 people (possibly around the Isle of Man and back or up to Scotland)

These will be allocated on a first donation basis. (To be arranged with Mr Bedwell)

These are fabulous incentives for people to donate and should certainly help to boost our final total.

*We are now setting up a JUST GIVING page for the event through Halsall PTFA, where all funds will be earmarked for the project. We'll let you know when it is available.

Alternatively people can just send a donation into school. (cheques payable to Halsall PTFA)

Basic Skills Quality Mark

I am pleased to announce that following a rigorous assessment by the LEA , we have once again, been awarded the Basic Skills Quality Mark. Gardener`s Corner

June at-a-glance

June is the month when the weather improves in leaps and bounds and so does the garden. Summer flowers make their first appearance; roses are in full bloom and powerful with scent. There`s still lots to keep on top off in June – but don`t forget to leave time to sit and enjoy the view.

Happy gardening.

General Garden Tasks

Water & deadhead plants regularly.

Remove perennial weeds.

Propagate roses & shrubs by taking softwood cuttings

Keep on top off training climbing & rambling roses & tie in clematis.

Layer clematis.

Prune Clematis Montana if necessary.

Continue to clip privet & other fast growing hedges.

Dig up tulip & hyacinth bulbs when foliage dies off & store dry bulbs in a cool dry, dark dry place ready to replant in autumn.

Plant out summer bedding plants.

Sow winter & early spring plants in trays under glass.

Water & feed containers & hanging baskets regularly.

Continue planting green-house grown frost-tender vegetables outside.

Transplant leek & brassica seedlings.

Keep all fruit trees well watered in dry weather.

Thin heavy crops of plums, apples, & pears.

Prune fan-trained apple or pear trees if necessary.

Harvest rhubarb & strawberries.

Continue to pot up rooted cuttings.

Take cuttings from fuchsias & pelargoniums.

Continue pollinating melons & remove male flowers from cucumbers.

Introduce new fish.

Watch out for

Lily beetle.

Blackspot, powdery mildew & rust on roses.

Blackfly on broad beans.

Moles.

Plants in their Prime

Roses. Clematis. Potentilla. Philadelphus. Geranium (hardy). Hosta. Bearded iris.

Alstromeria. Convolvulus. Cytisus. Cornus. Deutzia. Sambucus. Spirea. Hebe. Achillea.

Anthemis. Campanula. Centurea. Corydalis. Delphinium. Lamium. Nepeta. Persicaria.

Tiarella. Veronica. Verbascum. Aquilegia. Dianthus. Lathyrus.



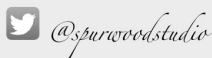
