Halsall Astronomical Events



On the invitation of Scout leader Alan Pope I had the privilege before Christmas of conducting a session on Astronomy with 16 local scouts and beavers at the village school, where with the aid of my 500mm telescope we were able to view the planet Jupiter and the craters on the Moon. When the sky clouded over we went in the hall to do a series of fun exercises about the solar system with the children taking relative positions of the planets and copying the rotation around the Sun. This session enabled the children to achieve their Astronomy badge.

There is much to view in the night sky especially in a rural area like Halsall. Often people post pictures of sunrises and sunsets which are remarkable. Pictures of the night sky are more difficult to obtain and yet since my arrival here thirty years ago and despite the increase in light pollution, I have witnessed amazing phenomena including breathtaking views of the aurora borealis (Northern lights) especially the night of 6th April 2000 which lasted from 9.30pm to 4.00 am. In November 1993 there was an amazing meteor storm with meteors visible every 10 seconds from midnight. The year 1997 we were visited by the very bright comet Hale- Bopp which was visible to the naked eye and hung for several weeks in the western sky after sunset.

The total eclipse of the Sun in 1999 was not visible from Halsall. I was fortunate to be in France but a partial eclipse covering most of the Sun was seen in the north west under clear skies. In November 2001 another great display of aurora was visible here from dark locations. In 2003 there was a conical zone of light after dark above the horizon which is called zodiacal light. The year 2004 saw a transit of Venus under clear skies. The transit is a very rare event and was discovered by Jeremiah Horrocks in Little Hoole north of Tarleton in 1639. The village church of St Michael, which is usually open and welcoming, commemorates the event in a stained glass window. There have been several lunar eclipses when the Earth casts a shadow on the Moon but these are regular occurrences and on 25th March 2015 there was a partial eclipse of the Sun during glorious weather.

Though light pollution is now a considerable problem even in rural Halsall there is much to see on a clear night if you persevere, not least meteor showers and planets and eyes to the north on clear nights because we are entering a maximum for solar winds which give more instances of Northern lights.





Gardener`s Corner

March at-a-glance

Remember the old rhyme about March winds & April showers? – Adding, a sharp frost can still catch you out but, the sun often shines this month and when it does you can almost see the new gardening season gathering steam daily. Happy Gardening.

General Garden Tasks

Spring clean the garden – fork over the soil in borders, weed & mulch, & dig up & divide overcrowded perennials.

Remove weeds & moss on paths & drives.

Deal with worm casts & molehills.

Make the first lawn cut if dry enough.

Redefine lawn edges.

Lay turf before the end of the month if not done in autumn.

Plant pot-grown shrubs, roses & climbers.

Prune modern bush roses, vigorous climbing roses, dogwoods & willows.

Tidy up patio roses, ground cover roses & shrub roses.

Move deciduous trees & shrubs & plant new bare-root plants.

Renovate overgrown climbers.

Tidy up rock garden, alpine screes & sink gardens.

Sow wildflowers & hardy annuals.

Divide snowdrops `in the green`.

Scrub or pressure-wash patio slabs.

Prepare soil, then sow lettuce, rocket, radishes, spring onions, leeks, broad beans & peas.

Plant onion sets & shallots.

Plant early potatoes grown in pots undercover; plant outdoors at the end of the month.

Sow hardy herbs & plant & divide perennial herbs.

Plant rhubarb, pot-grown fruit trees & bushes & strawberry plants.

Prune standard apple & pear trees before the buds burst into growth.

Hand-pollinate peaches, nectarines & apricots & protect early blossom with fleece.

Sow tomatoes, chillies, sweet-peppers, aubergines & half-hardy annuals under glass.

Watch out for

Slugs, snails, woodlice & greenfly under glass.

Mice in sheds & greenhouses.

On cold nights cover vulnerable plants with fleece.

Daffodils. Crocus. Lily-of-the-valley. Tulips. Magnolia Stellata. Chaenomeles. Forsythia. Camellias. Amelancheir Lamarckian. Aubrietia. Primula. Wallflowers. Cornus. Azara. Spiraea. Skimmia japonica. Viburnum tinus. Jasmine. Scilla. Garrya. Clematis `Freckles`. Malus. Scilla
