To be chosen for something special can mean a great deal, anything from being chosen for a school play to being asked to be best man or a Godparent. We all like to feel needed, to feel special. Well it would be hard to think of a more important and amazing privilege than being asked to be mother to the Son of God. Mary must have amazed, frightened and yet ultimately willing to say yes to God. She would have wondered what the future held. 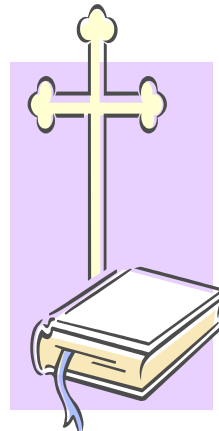

FRACKING YES OR NO?

TESLA EXPLORATION INTERNATIONAL LTD. HAVE ADVISED HALSALL PARISH COUNCIL THAT THEY WILL SHORTLY BE CARRYING OUT A "3D" SEISMIC SURVEY IN HALSALL ON BEHALF OF AURORA ENERGY RESOURCES LTD. WHO HOLD PETROLEUM EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT LICENCE NO. 164. IN THEIR LETTER THEY HAVE ADVISED THAT THIS WILL LAST FOR APPROX. 4 WEEKS AND WILL INVOLVE THE LAYING OUT OF AN ARRAY OF GEOPHONES (RECORDING DEVICES) ACROSS THE SURVEY AREA AND THE RECORDING OF REFLECTED SIGNALS GENERATED FROM AN ARRAY OF SEISMIC SOURCES. THE SOURCES ARE GENERATED BY "SMALL" BURIED CHARGES OR BY SPECIALISED TRACTOR-LIKE VEHICLES FITTED WITH VIBRATING PLATES. THIS IS TO PROGRESS AURORA' S TECHNICAL UNDERSTANDING OF THE LICENCE AREA PRIOR TO MAKING ANY APPLICATION FOR FUTURE EXPLORATORY DRILLING.

AURORA AND TESLA HAVE BOTH WRITTEN TO THE PARISH COUNCIL AND INVITED QUESTIONS. THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS SET UP A WORKING GROUP TO CONSIDER AND REPORT UPON A RESPONSE TO THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THESE LETTERS. THIS HAS BEEN DELIVERED TO THE PARISH COUNCIL FOR DISCUSSION AT THEIR MEETING ON 9TH APRIL 2014. THE WORKING PARTY IS COLLATING FEEDBACK ON THIS NEWS AND WOULD BE GLAD TO HEAR FROM RESIDENTS WHO MAY HAVE QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS IN THIS CONNECTION. PLEASE CONTACT THE WORKING GROUP:

FURTHER DETAILS:

TESLA HAVE EXPLAINED THAT THE SURVEY IS PART OF AURORA'S ONGOING APPRAISAL OF THE AREA FOR POTENTIAL HYDROCARBON (OIL AND GAS) RESERVES.

THEY HAVE ADVISED THAT THEIR SURVEY WILL BE CONDUCTED BETWEEN 0730-1730 HRS 7 DAYS A WEEK AND, DAYLIGHT HOURS PERMITTING, THEY WOULD WISH TO EXTEND THE WORKING DAY BEYOND 1730HRS "SHOULD IT BE DEEMED NECESSARY". THE SURVEY UNIT WILL COMPRISE 4 30 TONNE TO 6 ATV UNITS, AND 2 TRANSIT VANS. THEY INTEND TO DEVELOP A SURVEY GRID NETWORK OF THE AREA AND THE DEPTH OF THE DEEPLY BURIED ROCK LAYERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY RECORDING THE TIME IT TAKES FOR "SMALL" BURIED EXPLOSIVE CHARGES OR VIBRATING TRACTOR UNITS, TO BE REFLECTED OFF THE VARYING ROCK INTERFACES BACK TO THE SURFACE WHERE THEY WILL BE DETECTED AND RECORDED.

SHOULD THE SURVEY BE ENCOURAGING IT IS LIKELY THAT AURORA WILL SEEK PLANNING PERMISSION TO DRILL "ONE OR TWO" EXPLORATORY WELLS.

RESIDENTS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT IF THIS GOES AHEAD IT COULD POSSIBLY LEAD TO A PROCESS KNOWN AS "HYDRAULIC FRACTURING" OR "FRACKING" IN HALSALL.

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS, OF COURSE, SET OUT MANY QUESTIONS FOR AURORA AND TESLA (ALSO LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL AND WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL). PLEASE WATCH THE HALSALL NEWS FOR FURTHER UPDATES AND FEEL FREE TO CONTACT THE WORKING GROUP OR YOUR COUNCILLORS IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS.

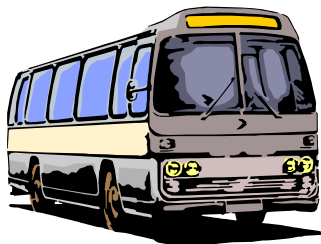

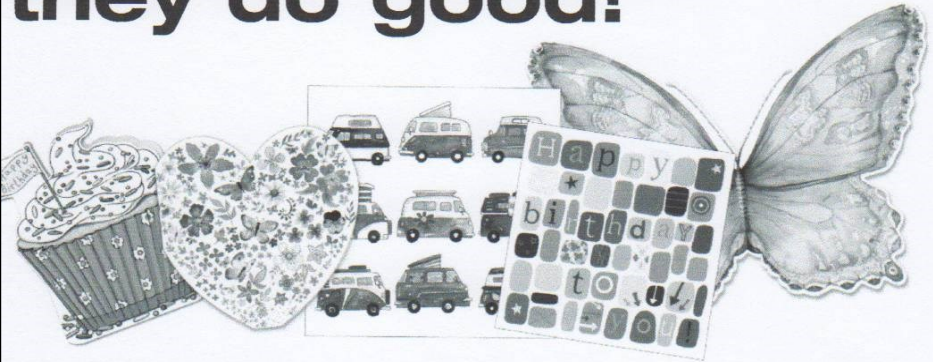

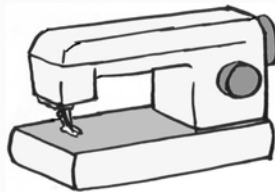

May at-a-glance

May is, for me, one of the most exciting & loveliest months of the year in the garden, because you can see new flowers opening every time you step outdoors & the best of the year is still to come. Longer evenings and warmer weather brings out the gardener in all of us. Happy gardening.

General garden Tasks

Prepare the soil for bedding plants.

Keep on top of weeding & hoeing –its endless I know!

Watch out for and deal with pests using biological controls & organic remedies.

Feed established lawns if not done in April.

Pinch out any green shoots appearing on variegated trees & shrubs.

Tie in new growth of climbers & wall shrubs.

Clip beech, hornbeam, box & Leyland cypress late this month or early next.

Cut privet.

Support perennials.

Divide clumps of primroses & polyanthus after flowering.

Continue deadheading & feeding spring-flowering bulbs.

Plant & train sweet peas. Plant tubs, troughs, window boxes & hanging baskets in the middle of this month at the earliest.

Sow swede, beetroot, main crop carrots, peas, radish & spring onion.

Direct-sow frost-tender vegetables, e.g. French & runner beans, sweetcorn & courgettes.

Plant out leeks.

Harvest overwintered onions.

Water soft fruit bushes with swelling fruit & newly planted fruit trees.

Protect strawberries from birds.

Continue to prick out seedlings, young plants & cuttings.

Continue hardening off bedding plants ready for end of month outdoor planting.

Plant tomatoes in early may & sweet peppers, chillies, melons & cucumbers late May.

Harvest baby potatoes.

Divide overgrown water lilies in the pond.

Introduce new fish to the water garden now the weather is warmer.

Watch out for

Late frosts – protect with fleece.

Pests in the greenhouse & containers.

Plants in their Prime

Rhododendrons. Clematis `Nelly Moser`. Clematis Montana. Viburnum.

Dianthus. Wisteria. Euphorbia. Geum. Lonicera. Corydalis. Rosa `Lutea`. Tree peonies. Chaenomeles. Cotoneaster. Kerria japonica. Potentilla. Sambucus nigra. Spiraea. Caellia.
