

YOUR READER WRITES...

A man said to his girlfriend, "On this Valentine's Day, I want to tell you something... I may not be rich like Jake, I don't have a huge house like Aaron and I don't have a Bentley like Alex. But I do love you and I want to marry you." His girlfriend replied, "I love you too! Now what was that you said about Alex?"

Valentine's Day falls on 14th of this month. It's considered a day when people can declare their romantic interest in someone, and it's a popular time for marriage proposals. St Valentine is the patron saint of (among other things) love!

It's easy to be cynical (especially when you've celebrated as many Valentine's Days as I have) about the inflated price of red roses and the profits Hallmark Cards (and others) make on this day. My step-father NEVER sent a card to my mother on Valentine's Day, insisting that he shouldn't need a card to tell her he loves her (although he wasn't inclined to tell her in words either!).

Soppy love (particularly in the first flushes of a romance is a lovely thing) – except for those who have to witness it!! And the hope is that the romance of a young relationship will be underpinned by shared experiences over a lifetime. I love the musical "Fiddler on The Roof". For those who haven't seen it, a poor dairy farmer in Russia over 100 years ago has five daughters. The tradition was that a matchmaker would arrange marriages in due course. He struggles with the fact that his daughters fall in love and aren't amenable to the input of the matchmaker. Reflecting upon this, he asks his wife (who he married, naturally in an arranged marriage, 25years previously) if she loves him. Her response is "For twenty-five years I've washed your clothes, cooked your meals, cleaned your house, given you children, milked the cow...if that's not love what is?" Love can be known by its deeds but it's still nice to hear it expressed in words.

Love is at the heart of our faith. A few bible verses (chosen from over 300) tell us something about Christian love. Love comes for God, whose very nature is love.

We love because he (God) first loved us. (1 John 4:19)

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. (1 John 4:7-8)

No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. (1 John 4:12)

Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. (1 Corinthians 13)

Planning Applications:

2018/1283/LDC - Gibbons Barn, Plex Lane - Certificate of Lawfulness - Use of land as a domestic garden.

PARKING ALONG SUMMERWOOD LANE

Cars parking either side of Summerwood Lane at school times and when funerals and weddings are taking place at St Cuthbert's are causing an obstruction and prevent large vehicles, including the emergency services from passing through.

Please use the Memorial Hall car park whenever possible.

PARKING ON NEW STREET NEAR TO THE JUNCTION WITH CARR MOSS LANE

This is creating a dangerous situation for cars trying to turn out of Carr Moss Lane because their line of sight is obstructed and we would ask that people refrain from parking so close to the junction before a serious accident occurs.

PARKING ON CARR MOSS LANE NEAR TO THE JUNCTION WITH LINEKAR DRIVE

Once again the Parish Council would ask people to use some common sense when parking their cars and not to park so close to the junction as to restrict residents of Linekar Drive from being able to see oncoming cars approaching from both directions when exiting the drive.



Gardener`s Corner

February at-a-glance.

The first signs of spring are starting to appear if you don't mind going out to look for them! February is a subtle month with catkins and the first bulbs cautiously pushing their heads above the wintery earth, while keen gardeners desperately look for some real gardening to do. Happy gardening.

General Garden Tasks

Make new beds and borders

Finish off winter digging

Order plug plants

Prune certain types of clematis – refer to a good gardening book for exact advice

Renewal – prune old shrubs, deciduous hedges and climbers

Brush snow off conifers, large evergreens and hedges to avoid splaying or breaking

Move deciduous trees and shrubs (ideally do this in November or early March)

Plant lily-of-the-valley crowns

Keep deadheading any winter flowering pansies or polyanthus in tubs and hanging baskets

Water and top-dress plants in year-round tubs and container grown herbs

Prepare soil ready for sowing, covering it with polythene sheeting to warm it up for early vegetables

Plan shallots and Jerusalem artichokes.

Prune autumn-fruiting raspberries now, and plant new canes between now and mid-march

Protect strawberries with horticultural fleece

Finish winter-pruning standard apple and pear trees

Ventilate the greenhouse at every opportunity, but water as little as you can get away with

Pot up stored dahlia tubers and lily bulbs

Spray fuchsias with water on fine days to start them back into growth

Chit potatoes if you didn't get chance last month

Take precautions to make sure your pond never freezes over entirely

Get-a-head

Prepare the greenhouse before the season gets fully underway –clean water storage barrels, watering cans, pots and seed trays, propagator and greenhouse glass.

Plants in their Prime

Hellebores, Hamamelis, Viburnum, Mahonia japonica, Sarcococca, Skimmia japonica `Rubella, Clematis `Freckles`, Jasmine, winter- flowering pansies, Saxifraga apiculata, Daphne mezereum, Abeliophyllum distichum (white forsythia), Sempervivums

Bulbs – Iris reticulata, Crocus, Narcissus (varieties) scilla, Anemone blanda




