January 1869.

- Wednesday 20. Today's Dictation has been badly done by Standards IV. V. VI. Out of 15 boys there were 7 failures. This is owing to a want of thought in many cases, as I am sure every boy could spell every word.
- Thursday 21. Standard II a transcription lesson. Many made mistakes in spelling, and were made to write it over again.
- Friday 22. Standard II had a dictation lesson. The spelling in a few cases was bad.
- Monday 25. James Snape came to School this morning. He is the worst boy in the School he is only 9 years old and has got the mastery over his Mother.
- Tuesday 26. Upper Standards reviewed four chapters in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Book of Samuel. The boys who have been irregular in attendance are dull.
- Wednesday 27. Standard III spelling the hardest words from their Reading Books. This exercise was done badly by most of the boys.
- Thursday 28. Standard IV Dictation which was better done.
- Friday 29. All Standards went through their subjects for examination.

Monday. 8. All Standards except lowest had  
a Bible Lesson. Boys in lower Standards  
answer better than those in higher.

Tuesday. 9. Holiday. Shrove Tuesday.

Wednesday. 10. Began the new Reading Books to day.

Thursday. 11. Standard III improved in Multipli-  
cation Tables. Must be exercised in them  
well 10 minutes each day.

Friday. 12. Four Boys left the School because they had  
to buy their own Reading Books. They are  
all bad attenders at School, and get

dances, so that the school will not lose anything by them.

Monday. 15. Standard III gets on well with the New Reading Book. Most can spell fairly.

Tuesday. 16. Standard IV. does not get on well at all. It is composed of boys who are very dull, and whom I have found it very difficult to get them up at all to their former Standard.

Wednesday. 17. Standard IV getting on fairly with the New Reading Book.

Thursday. 18. Standard IV. imperfect in their Compound Addition. W<sup>m</sup> Rotherham is the dullest boy in this Standard.

Friday. 19 All the School the Church Catechism.  
John Gates cannot do his notation.

Monday. 22. George Park in Standard III. cannot do his notation.

Tuesday. 23. Lower Standard a Scripture Lesson on the Destruction of Sodom.

Wednesday. 24 Standards I. & II. wrote out an account, in their Books, of Shud. Thos. Mawdsley. Peter Clark & John Alsall did it very fairly.

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- Thursday 25 Standards II. III. IV taken in a portion of the Book of Genesis.

- Thursday 27. Standard II worked sums in the

- Friday 28. All the School had the Church  
 Catechism to day.
- Monday 31. Lower Standards taken in the History  
 of Joseph.
- Tuesday 1 June. Questioned Upper Standard on  
 the Lessons they had received on St Matthew's  
 Gospel. Several boys in these Standards  
 are very dull. John Gates, R<sup>t</sup>. Shearman  
 James Marshall, Edward Dalton, Wm.  
 Rotherham the worst.
- Wednesday 2. Standard Standards I. II repeat the  
 early part of the Church Catechism.
- Thursday 3. Upper Standards had a lesson on a  
 portion of the Apostles Creed.
- Friday 4. Standard II. examined in simple  
 Subtraction. Improved since the last  
 examination.

June 1869.

- Monday 4. Many boys away working in the fields. This keeps the school backward.
- Tuesday 8. Gave Standard I a writing lesson. Most can make their letters fairly.
- Wednesday 9. Standards I. II. had a dictation lesson today. Some mistakes made through carelessness. The boys who made them were made to write them over again.
- Thursday 10. Questions in Scripture put on the Black Board for Upper Standards to write answers on Slates. Many boys have no idea of composition.
- Friday 11. Questions involving weights & measures set for Standards I. II. John Reale & Sam<sup>t</sup>. Shaw did two. The rest did all the sums.
- Monday 14. Standard III exercised in Multiplication and Division Tables. The boys in his Standard are as sharp as the boys in Standard IV.
- Tuesday 15. Standards IV. V. VI. work down in their exercise a parable. All succeeded except R<sup>d</sup>. Stearns. This is a most idle stupid boy.

June 1869

Wednesday 16. Standard II learning Multiplication Table under Monitor.

Thursday 17. Standards V. VI. Went through Tables of aliquot parts. Wts. and Measures. Two boys had forgotten a portion of them.

Friday 18. All School the Catechism. Upper Standards questioned on it.

Monday 21. Upper Standards read the 24<sup>th</sup> Chap. of St Matthew and were questioned on it.

Tuesday 22. Went over old ground in the Judges.

Wednesday 23. Dictation in Standard IV. bodily done. R. G. Sherman had 7 mistakes

Thursday 24. Standard II. had a long transcribing lesson. They must have this exercise open. Many are backward in writing.

Friday 25. A lesson to all the Standards on a portion of the Apostles Creed.

Monday 28. Many boys late this morning. They were let off with a caution

Tuesday 29. Standards II. V. VI got as far as the Judge Abdon to day.

Wednesday 30. Questioned Standards I. II. III on the book of Genesis. Book up to day for a month holiday.

August 1869.

- Monday. 9. Commenced the 2<sup>nd</sup> half year to day, after 5 weeks holiday, with 60 boys.
- Tuesday. 10. Found most boys had forgotten a great deal of what they knew before.
- Wednesday. 11. Fourth Standard Dictation much worse than before the holidays.
- Thursday. 12. Thomas and Charles Howard have been playing truant the whole of to day, and have persuaded James Harrison to accompany them.
- Friday. 13. The "travants" came this morning and were severely punished.
- Monday 14. The liberation of Peter from the hands of Arod to the whole School.
- Tuesday 15. Standard IV Careless in their sums. They all appear to be asleep.
- Wednesday 16. Arithmetic in Standard II nearly forgotten. Thomas Grimshaw one of the most ill boys.
- Thursday 17. Lower Standards learning the Catechism under the Monitor.
- Friday 18. Upper Standards said the Catechism many imperfect.

August 1869.

- Monday 23. The history of Samson given to the whole school. Standards IV-V-VI required to write down what they knew of it.
- Tuesday 24 Exercised Standards III-IV in Mental Arithmetic.

Friday 3.

Upper Standards had questions in arithmetic involving Reduction, Compound Rules, and Weights and Measures. John Keeler could not do a single sum. Several of the boys did all.

Monday 6

Holiday. Annual treat to the Scholars at the Rectory.

Tuesday 7.

Many boys late this morning. Boys questioned in their old scripture lessons. The dull boys in Standard IV answer worse than the lower standards.

Wednesday 8.

Standard I. II. Learning the <sup>Catechism</sup> Scriptures under a monitor.

Thursday 9.

Exercised Upper Standards in Mental arithmetic. They are very slow at it.

Friday 10.

All the schools <sup>The Church</sup> catechism. Impressed.

September 1869.

- Monday. 13. Standard IV kept in to learn the lesson.  
Rt Sherman. James Gates. Edward Dalton, & John Gates are very dull boys.
- Tuesday. 14. Paper Examination in Arithmetic to Standards V. VI. Figures badly formed and sums worked inaccurately.
- Wednesday. 15. Catechism to Standards I. II and Monitor.
- Thursday. 16. Geography to Standards IV. V. VI.
- Friday. 17. Paper Examination to Standard II  
Figures made badly and sums worked inaccurately.
- Monday. 20. Scripture Lesson to Lower Standards.
- Tuesday. 21. Standard II a long transcription lesson on their Exercise Book. Writing better than in dictation exercise.
- Wednesday. 22. Four Standards III. IV. V. VI.  
Say the Catechism.
- Thursday. 23. Geography lesson to Upper Standards  
Examined them also in the last Geography Lesson. The dull boys appear to know better about it.

September 1869.

- Friday 24. A lesson to the Upper Standards on the First part of the Catechism.
- Monday 27 Geography to Standard IV-VI. examined them also in their old Geography Lessons.
- Tuesday 28. Dictation in Standards VI unsatisfactory Samuel Shaw made six mistakes. This boy loses a great deal of time by staying at home.
- Wednesday 29. Day very wet. Few boys in attendance.
- Thursday 30. The Curate gave the Upper Standards a Scripture Lesson.
- Friday 1. October. Lesson in Geography. Examination in the Simple Rules to Standard VII. Five boys failed.

November 1869.

They had crossed off words and blotted in several places.

Tuesday. 9. John Deale kept in to get off history  
and spelling. This is a most idle boy.  
Wednesday. 10. Gave Standard IV a dictation  
lesson. Many mistakes made  
which were the result of carelessness.

Thursday. 11. Scripture lesson to the Lower Stan-  
dards.

Friday. 12. Mr. Heene came and gave a  
Scripture lesson to Standard IV. V. VI.

Monday. 13. Heard lower part of Standard I  
read. Boys much improved.  
At midsummer they could only  
tell their letters. Now they can read  
the 1<sup>st</sup>. Book moderately.

Tuesday. 14. Standard II did a few sums in  
Simple Long Division.

Wednesday. 15. Standard IV began to learn tables  
of weights & measures. Wm. Rotherham
